MOSEY FAMILY NEWS

MAY 31, 2010



We are amazed and thankful for the opportunities God has given us since we arrived in Bermuda on May 1st. These opportunities for learning, growth, and ministry have far exceeded our expectations. We have attended sixteen *Word of Life* Bible club meetings (at six different locations) and we have been privileged to teach at four of them.



Word of Life Bermuda facilitates Bible clubs both at churches and at schools. The school clubs are either during the lunch hour (at the high schools) or after school (at the middle schools). The staff here has been approached by primary schools which are interested in having clubs, but they are waiting for God's timing and His provision of more staff to meet that need.

Please pray for the staff in Bermuda, and for Mark Hall who leads the ministry here, and is the regional director for all of *Word of Life* in the Caribbean. Pray for wisdom and direction as they look to "reproduce" in other countries the ministry that God has blessed them with here in Bermuda. Pray that God will send more laborers into these ripe fields.



Our greatest desire is to be used of God, in an effective way, to reach those He directs us to reach, for His glory. We have seen (and are seeing) Him teach us and lead us in ways we could not have imagined. One of those ways is this time of hands on training in Bermuda. Along with the many opportunities to participate weekly in the clubs and help with the largest children's event of the year (more in the next paragraph), we have been attending the weekly administrative planning meetings and receiving two days per week of personalized training with the director.



Saturday the 15th was the annual Olympian Game Day. Weeks beforehand, the very organized staff had been preparing everything needed for this exciting day, including: 20 different carnival-type games, a food and snack tent, plus awards and ribbons. Set up began the night before and continued early Saturday morning. Then, 224 children from several different Olympian clubs arrived and enjoyed playing the games for hours. After lunch, they marched into the gymnasium and heard a clear, simple, and exciting presentation of the Gospel. And 59 children responded to the invitation to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Amen!



Moser Mission



Sightseeing on Saturdays (on the scooter) has been an adventure. We quickly adapted to driving on the left hand side, but the narrow roads are still a bit scary at times. After living in southwest Florida for eleven years, going to the beach was not a "big deal" to us... but we never saw beaches like this in Florida. We haven't been in the water, but we have enjoyed a couple of walks in the pink sand and climbing on the cliffs and rocks. Not to mention the crystal clear blue water!



Stuart and Kearstin will finish classes at the Word of Life Bible Institute on June 4th, have a short break, then begin summer ministry at the Inn and Conference Center. They continue to learn God's Word in depth, and make their faith personal. They have both enjoyed their ministry opportunities in local churches and in the community this school year. Please continue to pray God's leading and direction for them, and for His plans to be carried out in their lives.



The same day they finish classes, we arrive back in Schroon Lake and continue our training at the annual missionary training conference. God has opened the door for Tina and I to serve on the Program team for the Word of Life Ranch this summer. This will be eight weeks of camp with 6 to 11 year old children. Since working with children is our heart beat, this time of ministry is a thrill for us!

God is working in great ways to prepare us to do the work He has for us to do, and we thank you for being a vital part of that with your prayers and financial support. Your generosity is allowing us to reach many children and families! We praise God for your faithfulness and support!





HEALTH KITS AND LAYETTES

Two of our Lutheran World Relief Projects are making Health Kits and School Kits. These kits provide much needed supplies to many people around the world. Items that go into each kit are:

Health Kits

- 1 hand towel (dark color)
- 1 wash cloth (dark color), 1 bath size bar of soap
- 1 adult size toothbrush, 1 nail clipper with file
- 1 wide tooth comb, 6 band-aids

School Kits

- Padded or spinal notebooks of ruled paper approx. 8 1/2" X 11" totaling 150-200 sheets; do not include loose leaf paper
- 1 blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- 1 30-centimeter ruler, or ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- 1 pencil sharpener, 1 eraser approx. 2 1/2 " long
- 6 new, unsharpened #2 pencils with erasers; secure together with a rubber band
- 12 sheets of construction paper in assorted colors
- 1 box of 16 or 24 crayons
